Irene has come and gone, leaving evidence of her entrance and exit. As licensed professionals, the opportunity to assess what she did to your property (residential or commercial) is here. Preliminary assessments are available to all at no cost as manpower and time allows.

Fallen trees, change in stream bed/direction, washing out of driveways, bridges, and roads has changed the once familiar landscape.

Those who have incurred damage to their yard, driveway, home, business, or other property structures should take advantage of this opportunity. Free assessments are available to you even if applications/claims to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and/or your insurance company have been submitted. Our goal is to provide property owners with information that will help them begin to rebuild. Description of physical damage to property structures can be described in brief detail at the bottom of Page 3 (Assessment Form). We have also included a “Things to Think About” on page 2 to help you determine the needs you may have. Things to Think About

Visual indicators of instabilities are important, however, they are not the initial indicator of danger present. They are indicator of the degree of damage.

Foundation: Movement, cracks, wash-out, collapse, undermined, sink-hole around foundation.

Structure (above foundation): Movement, cracks, collapse, missing sheathing (plywood), hole in wall or roof, crooked windows and doors, roof, structure moved off foundation.

Roof: Missing shingles, exposed wood (sheathing or rafters).

Driveway: Washouts, rippling, cracks, scouring of ditches along driveway or road, washed out culvert or bridge.

Electric: Downed pole, exposed underground electric, hanging wires, electric panel damaged in house.

Erosion: Stream bank erosion, general erosion on property, specific erosion on property, deposition of material on property.

Water: Water entered building.

Septic System: Septic system washed out, sewage smell, toilets backing up, sewage on ground.

Building Red Tagged: Red tagged by building department of other agency, unsafe building, condemned.

These are possible on all building types and none are exempt from this voluntary assessment.
